

Term Limits Amendment

Background

Fifteen other states impose term limits on state legislators. Most states impose a limit of eight to 12 years in each chamber. It's time for Illinois to adopt legislative term limits.

Original Proposal

The Illinois Constitution should be amended to limit a Representative or Senator from holding that office or combination of those offices for more than 10 years.

- *Compromise Proposal:* In addition to legislative term limits, a constitutional amendment limiting executive office holders to only two four-year terms in any office should also be adopted.

Redistricting Amendment

Background

Legislators should not choose voters – voters should choose legislators. The current redistricting process gives too much power to career politicians. It's time to adopt an independent commission model to draw fair legislative maps.

New Proposal

Pass a constitutional amendment creating a new independent commission to ensure fair and balanced legislative districts.
