In 1984, Robert Clark founded Clayco as a start-up construction company. In that first year, Clayco's revenues reached \$1 million. Since then, Clark has grown Clayco into a financially strong company with annual revenues that topped \$800 million in 2011.

Today, the company consistently ranks among the top builders in America. Clayco specializes in real estate development, engineering, architecture and construction in Industrial, Corporate, Institutional and Residential markets in communities across the USA. As chairman and CEO, Clark spearheads the company's growth strategy and vision and also serves as the business group leader for the Downtown Chicago office.

The company is privately held and provides full-service, turnkey building services through its real estate services capabilities and fully integrated subsidiaries: Forum Studio, a fullservice architecture and design firm, and Concrete Strategies, a fully integrated self perform contracting company with over 600 employees.

Since its inception in 1984, Clayco has completed revenues of over \$10 billion, including over 180 million square feet of new construction and 40 million square feet of renovation work in the United States. The company has completed development of over 4,300 acres of land and is a leader in each of the markets served.

Prior to establishing Clayco, Clark was a partner at Machine Maintenance and Equipment Company (MMECO). Under Clark's stewardship, MMECO became the leading Midwest distributor for Ingersoll Rand and Gardner Denver products. Prior to MMECO, Clark served as Project Director at Clark Painting Company, one of the nation's largest industrial painting contractors founded by his father, Harold.
